## Introduction

These days, women have jobs of their own. They don't need you to provide for them, and if they do need a guy to provide for them, chances are they can get a guy to provide for them *without* having sex with him.

So remember: You can't buy her affection. She is not a prostitute. While a sexual relationship has a certain amount of give and take, it is not one thing in exchange for another. In short, buying things for a girl is a nice thing to do, and can be fun – but it is not going to get you laid *of itself*. That's why you're going to make sure you have other things going on in your life. Gym, writing, music, your circle of friends, football. Your life is complete without a girl, and hence, if one girl doesn't call you back – who cares. You have a cool life regardless, and you can always meet other girls.
